Homelessness in Pregnancy

A study of 133 singleton pregnancies in women in Dublin, Ireland who are homeless or living in refuge between 2013 and 2022. The analysis compared outcomes in this cohort to a reference population of 76,858 women with stable living arrangements.

Women in the homeless/refuge population were statistically more likely to be single (75% vs 40%), have an unplanned pregnancy (74% vs 27%), report a history of psychiatric illness (43% vs 22%), domestic violence (19% vs 1%) alcohol consumption in pregnancy (3% vs 0.8%) or smoking in pregnancy (41% vs 10%). They were significantly more likely to have a <u>preterm birth</u> (37 weeks or earlier). They also had a significantly lower median birth weight compared to the reference population (7 lb. 3 oz vs 7 lb.9 oz).

Conclusion

Women in the homeless and refuge population are more likely to experience poorer perinatal outcomes compared to women with stable living arrangements.
