RECORD HIGH NUMBER OF PEOPLE LIVING UNSHELTERED

In 2023, a record high 256,610 people, or 39.3% of all people experiencing homelessness, were unsheltered. Unsheltered refers specifically to individuals sleeping outside or in non-habitable places, while homeless is a broader term which encompasses both sheltered (living with friends, in a hotel, in an emergency shelter) and unsheltered individuals.
